Research

Art Appreciation

Look at your focus artist/type of art.

"Do you like it?"

"Does it look like a snail?"

"Would you add anything to change it?"

"Do you prefer it to his other collages?"

Key skills/techniques

Shape: To recognise shapes in pictures and cut out and arrange shapes to form a picture.



'The Snail' by Henri Matisse

The Snail is a collage made up of coloured paper which has been cut and glued onto a white piece of paper. The shapes are arranged in a spiral pattern.

Imitation

To create a snail Inspired by Henri Matisse by cutting and gluing shapes.

Medium

Evaluate

Children complete the evaluation template looking at what went well and what if they were to complete the piece of art again.

Creativity

Create a collage of a parrot using a range of different materials.

Inspiration

Look at colourful animals such as parrots.

Research them on the internet, in books or watch some clips online.

Explore a range of materials to see if they would be suitable for a collage of a parrot (shiny, feathers, dull, bright).
