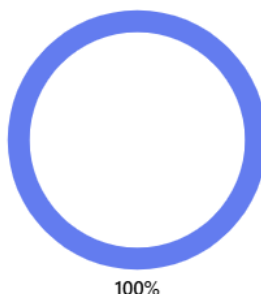
Seven respondents completed the questionnaire & the responses are as follows:

- The information on the website – **7**

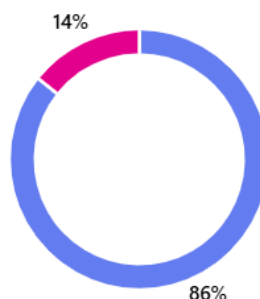

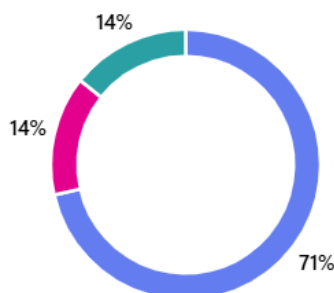

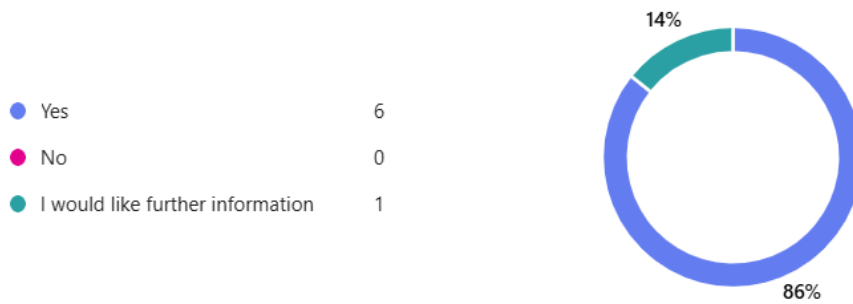

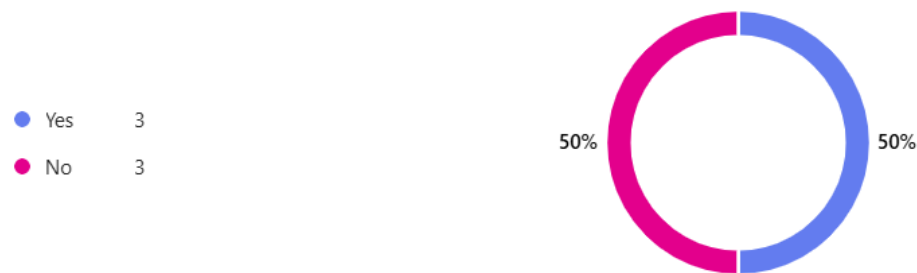
