Literacy

We will be looking at one book called Katie Dives Into Impressionism.



This term our **writing** focus will be to...

- Handwriting- Joining consistently throughout books.
- Checking for sense and for clarity so we are taking pride in our work and being the best writers, we can be.
- Writing opportunities- play scripts, poems, non- chronological reports and many more.

This term's spellings focus will be:

- Common exception words for Year 3 /4 - The prefix anti- and inter- - Words ending in -cian, -sion, -tion and -ssion

This term's reading focus will be:

- Using Katie Dives into Impressionism as the driver for our whole class reading.

- Developing our vocabulary, inference, prediction, explanation, retrieval, and summarizing skills as part of whole class reading.

- Developing our choral read skills and increasing in fluency and speed of reading.

- We ask that children regularly practise and learn their **times tables**. It has been proven to make a massive difference to the speed and accuracy of their calculation skills.
- Reading is important so please try and listen to your child **read at least three times** a week, this does not have to be a whole book, just 5 minutes or a few pages each time.
- PE will be on Monday and Friday's, P.E kits to be worn both days.
