Our topic for the Autumn Term is 'Toy Story.'



Over this half term, the children will....

- Travel into Space with Buzz, Zurg and the aliens.
 We will be reading a range of fiction and non-fiction texts and the internet to help us to learn more about space the solar system.
- Make use of lots of mark making opportunities including labels, lists, rhyming strings, captions and sentence building.
- Travel back in time to learn about a significant historical event: The Moon Landing.
- Compare toys from the past and present.
- Role play in our space mission control centre and on the surface of the moon.
- Use the small and large scale construction equipment to build rockets and space vehicles.
- Develop their painting skills we will be learning some different painting techniques used by famous artists and we will apply these techniques to create our own 'Night Sky' inspired paintings.
- Learn about Jesus and the Christian story in RE.
- Learn and perform traditional Christmas carols as part of our Christmas Nativity Concert.
- Join in with movement and dance sessions, pretending to be different Toy Story characters.
- Using the 'Draw and Tell' app to present our research about space and the solar system.
- Carry out a parachute investigation to explore gravity and air resistance.
- Our PSHE unit this term is 'Celebrating Differences' and the children will be learning mindfulness.
