With the Queen's Platinum Jubilee celebrations later this year, we thought it would be great for the children to learn about our monarch, Queen Elizabeth II. Over the coming weeks the children will....

- use non-fiction texts, photos and the internet to research the life of Queen Elizabeth and how life in Britain has changed during her reign.
- look at Queen Elizabeth's family tree and record our own family trees.
- read a range of stories linked to our royalty theme.
 We will use these to make our own story maps and to write simple stories.
- role play as different royal characters (and their servants!).
- make use of lots of mark making opportunities including labels, lists, rhyming strings, captions, sentence building, letter and instruction writing.
- develop their scientific knowledge, learning about reversible changed linked to winter weather (water freezing/melting).
- learn simple printing techniques in art and apply their knowledge of the properties of shapes to create a shape castle picture.
- learn about 'Special times for me and others' in RE, looking at celebrations in different faiths.
- continue to add to our growing repertoire of nursery rhymes, adding some royal rhymes including: Old King Cole, The Queen of Hearts...
- set targets in our PSHE unit this term 'Dreams and Goals'
- learn how to search for and find digital information in computing.
- develop their ball manipulation skills in PE sessions including different ways of sending, receiving and travelling with a ball.
