This half term our topic

has a history focus. We will be diving into more Julia Donaldson books to support our learning around the historical event of the Titanic. We will be comparing objects in daily life and toys from 1912 and present day. We will also be dressing up as first-class passengers aboard the Titanic and have afternoon tea. We also explore the 1st, 2nd and 3rd classes and how passengers had different experiences. We will also discover and explore the creation of the Titanic, the journey it made, and the disaster of the Titanic sinking. We will use role play to help understand this event, including who were prioritised for the limited lifeboats.

Science and understanding the world.

Literacy

This term our writing focus text is Jonty Gentoo. In our sequence of learning we will be writing. Tonty Gentoo

- Labels for images
- A character description
- A setting description
- A fact file

We will be having a big focus on letter formation. The children will have daily opportunities for writing and to further develop their fine motor skills.

Phonics. This year your child will be following the Little Wandle Phonics programme. Alongside this, your child will have opportunities to develop other skills needed for reading such as blending and segmenting. As their confidence and skills grow, they will be sent home with reading activities and/or books.

Reading at home

As your child progresses through the phonics programme, they will be sent home with decodable phonics books for them to read to you. These books will be accessed via the online Collins Hub. Hearing your child read at home is extremely important. Please listen to your child read at least three times a week. Daily reading makes a huge difference to progress!
