We are excited to have a fun filled half term looking at all things autumn, Bonfire Night, and many extra celebrations leading up to the festive period.

Eastfield Foundation Stage

Our topic for the Autumn 2 Term is a continuation of 'On The Move.' As we looked at the adventures of 'The Naughty Bus' last half term, we will now be moving out to Sea investigating the historic Titanic.

Over the coming weeks the children will

- Learn about time travels (Edwardian period) using information sources (photos, web searches, non-fiction books).
- Look at how the past compares to the present within toys, clothing, transport, homes, basic class system etc.
- We will use non-fiction texts and the internet to research information.
- Role play by boarding our titanic ship, having afternoon tea in the upper class lounge and organise lifeboats and life jackets in an emergency situation.
- Reception learn how to ride a bike
- We will investigate reversible change water and icebergs and look deeply into changes over time/decay - long-term effects of water and the wreckage of the titanic.
- Our PSHE unit this term is 'Being me in my world' and the children will be continuing to practice mindfulness.
- Within Art Nursery will learn about Jackson Pollock: Splatter Painting, while Reception learn about Van Gogh Starry Night (linked with bonfire night)
- Learn and perform a range of nursery rhymes -
- Learn about the importance of a promise, Noah's Ark and the Christmas Story in RE.
- Learn about Digital Images and using Draw & Tell on the iPad to retell the story.
