Requests for Statutory Assessments – update re EP Assessments

As demand for statutory assessments continue to rise, the Local Authority continue to seek solutions to how the 20-week assessment process can be effectively managed. If you have had an Educational Psychology assessment completed either by a Local Authority Educational Psychologist, or through another agency, we would be happy to consider this assessment alongside, observation and discussions with parents/carers and the education setting by one of our Local Authority EPs. Our Principal Educational Psychologist will be quality assuring any recent assessment submitted as part of the evidence bundle at when the initial request is received. To be a recent and relevant report it must have been completed within the last 6-8months and align to the discussions had with stakeholders and the observation of the learner. Please be advised that where there is any discrepancy between the written report and the observation or discussion, an assessment as part of the statutory process will still be required by a Local Authority Educational Psychologist. The Local Authority are aware that some children's needs can change significantly over a 6-8 month period and a fresh assessment would therefore still be required.

"All children and young people are entitled to an education that is appropriate to their needs, promotes high standards and the fulfilment of potential. This toolkit has been designed to support schools and settings by providing a systematic approach when supporting Children and Young People, who are experiencing emerging or sustained SEMH difficulties. It provides a range of supportive actions, strategies and resources to meet need and support the **Assess, Plan, Do, Review** process in schools."

Produced by Claire Gordon (NE Lincs Specialist Teacher for SEMH), the document provides information on:

- The Assess/Plan/Do/Review steps of the Graduated Response both from whole school/setting perspective and an individual child/young person perspective.
- Guidance to schools and settings about effectively evidencing the operation of the Graduated Response.
- A range of High-Quality Teaching, targeted and specialist interventions that schools and settings can use to support a child or young person.
- Details of and information about partner agencies intended to provide a directory of support available from the Local Area as described in the SEND Local Offer.
