# Year 3 Autumn Term 2019

## **Topic-**Flow

As geographers we will learn about all about rivers. We will visit Hubbard's Hills to get a first-hand experience of a river. We will learn about different soils around, the features and the formation of rivers. We will also look at the issues of pollution within rivers and seas.



## Maths

This term in maths we will focus on:

#### Place Value

- Counting in multiples
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number (hundreds, tens, ones).
- Finding 10 or 100 more or less than a given number.
- Comparing and ordering numbers up to 1000.

### Addition and Subtraction

- Adding and subtracting numbers mentally, including: a 3-digit no and 1s, 10s, 100s.
- Adding and subtracting numbers with up to 3 digits, using formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction.
- We ask that children practice their **times tables** regularly at home. The children need to be fluent with their 2, 5, 10, 3, 4 and 8 times tables by the end of year 3 and know the division facts related to these.
- Reading is really important so please try and listen to your child **read at least three times** a week, this does not have to be a whole book, just 5 minutes or a few pages each time.
- **PE will be on a Monday and a Tuesday** this term. PE kit is: plain blue/black shorts, white/red t-shirt and trainers or plimsolls.
- Please regularly check the **website** and **twitter** for up-to-date letters and information.

## Literacy

We will be looking at the book, 'Flotsam' by David Wiesner.

This terms writing focus will be to:

- Begin to use a range of conjunctions (because, but, although, therefore, so) and fronted adverbials (Slowly,... Through the forest,... Everyday,....)
- write a range of texts, such as recounts, poems, descriptions and non-chronological reports.

#### This terms **spellings** focus will be

- continuing to learn common exception words
- Suffixes (s, es, er, ed, ing)
- Prefixes (dis, un, mis, re)
- Apostrophes for contractions
- Words with the /ei/ sound spelt ei, eigh, aigh or ey and words with the /i/ sound spelt y

#### This terms **reading** focus will be

- Develop positive attitudes to reading by listening to and discussing a range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry.
- Drawing inferences about characters
- Identifying different structures within texts to begin to understand the differences in genres.
- Asking questions to further understanding
