Literacy

We will be looking at the book, 'Wild Girl' by Chris Wormell

This terms **writing** focus will be to:

- continue to use a range of conjunctions (because, but, although, therefore, so) and fronted adverbials (Slowly,... Through the forest,... Everyday,...)
- write a range of texts, such as informative leaflets, discussion texts and an adventure story.

This terms **spellings** focus will be

- continuing to learn common exception words
- prefixes sub and tele
- words with the /s/ sound spelt ch
- suffixes less, ness, ful and ly

This terms **reading** focus will be

- Understanding the meaning of words in different contexts.
- Making inferences and using the text or imagine to support inferences.

Maths

Multiplication and Division

1. multiplying two-digit numbers by a single digit

EG → $27 \times 3 =$

2. Solve problems and missing number problems, involving \times and \div ,

EG- Fred has five goldfish and Jake has four times as many. How many goldfish does Jake have?

Money

Add and subtract amounts of money to give change, using both £ and p in practical contexts.

Statistics

1. Interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables.

2. Solve one-step and two-step questions

EG → 'How many more?' and 'How many fewer?'

- We ask that children practice their **times tables** regularly at home. The children need to be fluent with their 2, 5, 10, 3, 4 and 8 times tables by the end of year 3 and know the division facts related to these.
- Reading is really important so please try and listen to your child **read at least three times a week**, this does not have to be a whole book, just 5 minutes or a few pages each time.
