Maths

Fractions

- Find a fraction of a number or amount. Such as $\frac{1}{4}$ of 12 or $\frac{3}{4}$ of 20.
- Know and identify equivalent fractions such as those which are equivalent to ¹/₂ (2/4, 3/6, 4/8) or 1/3 such as (2/6, 3/9, 4/12)
- Be able to add and subtract fractions (within 1)
- Be able to compare and order fractions.

Multiplication and Division Recap

- Use formal short multiplication
- Use known division facts and the formal 'bus stop' method.

Length

- 1. Measure in mm, cm and m
- 2. Compare and know equivalent measurements
- 3. Add and subtract: lengths (m/cm/mm)
- We ask that children practice their **times tables** regularly at home. The children need to be fluent with their 2, 5, 10, 3, 4 and 8 times tables by the end of year 3 and know the division facts related to these.
- Children will bring home a reading book. Reading is really important so please try and listen to your child **read at least three times** a week, this does not have to be a whole book, just 5 minutes or a few pages each time.
- Please regularly check the **website** and **Class Dojo** for up-to-date letters and information.

Literacy

We will be looking at the book 'Rainbow Bird- An Aboriginal Folk Tale' by Eric Maddern and Adrienne Kennaway.

This terms writing focus will be to:

- write a range of texts, such as descriptions, play scripts and short stories.
- Know and use different structural features of texts.
- continue to use a range of conjunctions (because, but, although, therefore, so)
- continue to develop the use of fronted adverbials (Slowly,... Through the forest,... Everyday,....)

This terms **spellings** focus will be:

- continuing to learn common exception words
- Suffixes (s, es, ly, ful, less, ness)
- Words which have a /i/ sound but spelt with alternative letters in words such as gym, pretty

This terms **reading** focus will be:

- Making inferences and using the text or images to support inferences.
- Use key points to summarise what has been read.
