- Handwriting- Joining consistently throughout books.
- Checking for sense and for clarity so we are taking pride in our work and being the best writers, we can be.
- Writing opportunities- narrative poetry, persuasive advertisements, writing instructions and a story with a personal experience.

This term's spellings focus will be:

- Common exception words for Year 3 /4 -Reviewing all prefixes and suffixes throughout the term to ensure this is embedded.

This term's reading focus will be:

- Using Coco Chanel as the driver for our whole class reading.

- Developing our vocabulary, inference, prediction, explanation, retrieval, and summarizing skills as part of whole class reading.

- Developing our choral read skills and increasing in fluency and speed of reading.

- We ask that children regularly practise and learn their **times tables**. It has been proven to make a massive difference to the speed and accuracy of their calculation skills.
- Reading is important so please try and listen to your child **read at least three times** a week, this does not have to be a whole book, just 5 minutes or a few pages each time.
