Our maths focus for this term will be ...

Decimals to...

- To understand numbers with three decimal places.
- To multiply decimals by integers.
- To divide decimals by integers.
- To divide decimals to solve problems.
- To convert fractions to decimals and vice versa.

Percentages to...

- To convert fractions to percentages.
- Find equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages.
- Order fractions, decimals and percentages.
- Find a percentage of an amount.
- Solve percentage problems with missing numbers.

Algebra to...

- Find a rule.
- Form expressions.
- We ask that children regularly practise and learn their **times tables**. It has been proven to make a massive difference to the speed and accuracy of their calculation skills.
- It is still important for children in Year 6 to be heard read. This way, the meaning of
 unfamiliar words can be discussed and vocabulary extended. Questions posed, arising from
 the text, is also an excellent way to develop children's understanding of what they have read.
 3 times a week is ideal.

- Use adverbs, preposition phrases and expanded noun phrases effectively to add detail, qualification and precision.

This terms spellings focus will be

- Use and apply homophones.
- Generating words from prefixes and root words.
- Correctly and confidently spell the statutory year 6 spellings and use them in writing.
- To proofread for spelling errors.

This terms **reading** focus will be

- To increase fluency in order to skim and scan effectively.
- To find evidence to support deductive and inference answers.
- To complete questions in a test format.
- To develop understanding of wider
