


Year 6

Spring Term 2026

Topic- South America

This term we will be continuing our learning all about World War Two. We will be using our historical skills to think about the impact it had on the UK and Immingham. We will then use all of our knowledge to answer the question 'Was Hitler a war criminal?' and give detailed



- We ask that children regularly practise and learn their **times tables**. It has been proven to make a massive difference to the speed and accuracy of their calculation skills.
- It is still important for children in Year 6 to be heard read. This way, the meaning of unfamiliar words can be discussed and vocabulary extended. Questions posed, arising from the text, is also an excellent way to develop children's understanding of what they have read. 3 times a week is ideal. I will be checking for 3 reads every Monday. Children can also log on to Reading Plus.
- PE will be on a Thursday and Friday. Children can come to school in their PE kits. Friday is swimming.

- **One page of SPaG and maths is encouraged as homework through CGP books. This will be checked each week.**

Maths

Our maths focus for this term will be ...

- To add and subtract fractions, including mixed numbers.
- To multiply and divide fractions.
- To find fractions of amounts and finding a whole.
- Solve multi operational problems involving decimals.
- Calculate percentages.
- To calculate perimeter and area.
- Understand the difference in angles and how they can be measured.
- To calculate volume.
- Revise conversions in capacity, mass and length.

We will be working hard to develop our arithmetic skills and answering questions at speed.

Literacy

We will continue looking at the book, 'Resist' by Tom Palmer. We will write a chapter that builds tension and suspense and includes dialogue and a biography.

This term our **writing** focus will be to...

- Identify the audience and purpose of their writing.
- Select the appropriate form and use other similar writing as models for their own.
- Ensure the consistent and correct use of tense throughout their piece of writing.
- Select appropriate grammar and vocabulary, understanding how such choices can change and enhance meaning.
- Use adverbs, preposition phrases and expanded noun phrases effectively to add detail, qualification and precision.

This terms **spellings** focus will be

- Use and apply a range of prefixes and suffixes to change meaning.
- Words with '-tial'/shul/
- Words beginning with 'acc'
- Correctly and confidently spell the statutory year 6 spellings and use them in writing.
- To proofread for spelling errors.

This terms **reading** focus will be

- To increase fluency in order to skim and scan effectively.
- To find evidence to support deductive and inference answers.
- To complete questions in a test format.
- To develop understanding of wider vocabulary.
