Combatting Online Bullying

Cyber-bullying can make victims feel upset, uncomfortable and unsafe. This can come on numerous forms such as hurtful comments, deliberately being left out, sharing images/videos and spreading gossip.

Remember to chat with your child regularly about who they may be chatting to online. Be vigilant in looking for changes in behaviour when they have been online such as being quieter than normal. Being jumpy, anxious and angry which is out of character, or repeatedly checking their phone.

Be available and prepared to listen. Sometime it may take time for your child to be able to share any concerns with you but when they do be ready to listen. These conversations can be upsetting and difficult for both you and your child but try not to show any judgement or criticism even if they haven't dealt with the situation exactly how you would have hoped.
