PTFA News

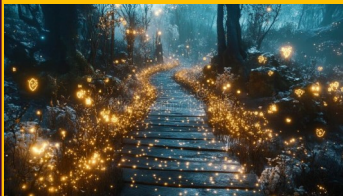

Kent Police - Violence Against Women and Girls (VAWG) Community Event

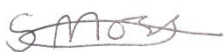
