### **Monday, 9 December - PTA Bags2school**

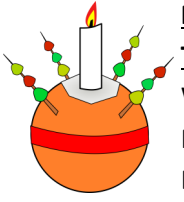
Don't forget that the bags will be collected on 9 December. The following 'good quality' items will be really appreciated:

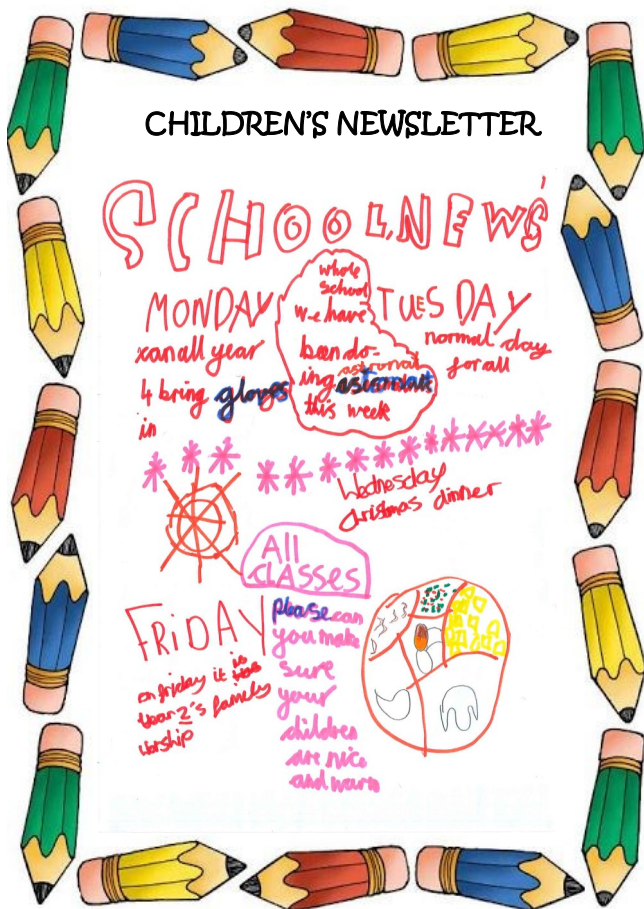


### Art Competition for Pilgrims Hospice

#### **Are you a budding artist?**

Why not take part in an art competition run by the Pilgrims Hospice and have an opportunity for your art work to be displayed at The Beaney Museum in Canterbury and be viewed by over 10,000 visitors.

The theme is 'What makes you unique?' Art work needs to be a minimum of A4 size and maximum of A2 including frame. All entries must be 2D artwork/photography and ready to hang - either framed or a box canvas both with mirror plates already attached. Entries need to be returned by 31 January and the school will then choose a maximum of 10 entries per year group for submission (The year groups are Years 3-6, Years 7-11 & Year 12-13.) Overall winners in the competition at the Beaney will be chosen by a judging panel with an additional 'Peoples vote' prize. Winners and their families will be invited to a prize giving ceremony later next year.
