## **INTERNET/ONLINE SAFETY SECTION**

### Social Media and Mental Health

It is estimated that a third of children have social media accounts, so it is important that trusted adults know what content young people are posting and interacting with. You may be daunted by how best to keep them safe but here are some useful tips to help;

- Understanding Algorithm Algorithm uses previous searches to recommend and send future feeds with similar content
- 2. Avoid Main Feeds - Avoid using the default settings on the social media app. Use settings to restrict content or prevent content not suitable for your child.
- Discuss what they have seen and learn how to hide content Chat to your child about what they 3. are viewing and use the hide options to prevent inappropriate content
- 4. **Set Daily Limits** - Use the apps or phone settings to set daily limits
- Monitor Activity Keep a discreet eye on how your child is using the account and occasionally ask 5. to see what they're looking at.
- Turn Off Push Notifications It's tempting to check messages as soon as they are received. Switch 6. off push notifications, they'll still be there later!
- 7. Encourage Other Activities - Mental health professionals highlight the importance of exercise and time away from screens
- Talk about Peer Pressure Talk to your child about peer pressure and listen to their concerns 8.
