INTERNET SAFETY SECTION

How your child can report anything worrying

It's important that young people know where to go if they come across something online that worries them or makes them feel uncomfortable – especially as contact with trusted sources of support may not always be available.

- help them to identify a trusted adult that they can approach and encourage them to the speak to the adult immediately if they have any concerns
- talk them through how they can make <u>a report to CEOP</u> if something has happened to them online or they're worried about what a friend is doing online and they feel they can't tell a trusted adult. The 'Click CEOP' button can be found at the bottom of each page on the school website.
- remind them that they can contact <u>Childline</u> if they have any other worries, for example if they are being bullied. They can also use the Internet Watch Foundation and Childline's <u>Report Remove</u> tool to report a image or video of themselves that's been shared online

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are delighted to confirm Elite are now in a position to deliver after school clubs again and will be running these clubs whilst maintaining bubbles for the children following all necessary Covid guidelines. We have also carried out a full risk assessment for the school. The information below outlines further details regarding the after-school club at your school for Term 4.

Multi-Sports → Every Thursday starting March 18th – April 1st

Years 3 & 4 (only) - 3:10pm – 4:10pm - £10.50 (3 weeks)

Multi-Sports → Every Friday starting March 19th – March 26th

Years 5 & 6 (only) - 3:10pm – 4:10pm - £7.00 (2 weeks)

Clubs will run weekly throughout the year with an emphasis on enjoyment, engagement and skill development with a variety of fun sporting games and activities. We also feel it is really important to highlight the achievements of all participants, so they are rewarded weekly for good behaviour, sportsmanship and effort with a Player of the Week medal.

Please be aware if this is a fee paying club <u>we do not accept cash or cheque payments</u> so please visit our website to book your place. If you do not book online please do not send your children to our course as it is most likely we are fully booked.

It is recommended that you book as soon as possible to avoid disappointment; online bookings will be available on Wednesday 3rd March.

If you have no means of paying online please contact the Elite team to arrange payment as our coaches will not take cash or cheques from parents at schools.

Children attending clubs must bring appropriate clothing and equipment. Those attending football club must at the very least bring shin pads, and it is recommended that children bring both football boots and suitable trainers. Parents should be aware that Elite coaches will not allow players without shin-pads or appropriate footwear to participate.

Elite are also running a fun and exciting Easter Half-Term course at the Three Hills Sports Park and Sibertswold Primary School. There will be activities such as Dodgeball, Bikes/Scooter, Gym/Dance however unfortunately our popular Inflatables course won't be available.
