School Attendance

Each term we let parents know about the current overall school attendance figure. At the end of term 2 this stood at 93.6% which is down 1.6% from term 1.

We understand that sometimes children are too unwell to attend school, or it can be difficult to know whether they should attend or not when feeling a little under the weather. Our leaflet 'A Guide for Parents/Carers on School Attendance' gives lots of helpful information about when to keep your child off of school or when it is fine for them to still attend. This leaflet was sent home with children in term 1 and copies are available from the school office, or this can be viewed on the school website under our Attendance page in the Parent tab.

Holiday Absence

As you may be aware in 2013 the Department for Education removed the ability for Headteachers to authorise absence for holidays unless under very exceptional circumstances. Further changes in 2024 saw new guidelines for issuing penalty notices to parents and carers who take their child/children out of school for holidays. Although we are required to let parents know about a penalty notice being requested, this is not issued by the school, neither do we receive the funds from a penalty notice. Penalty notices were introduced to help improve school attendance particularly when absence is due to holidays and unauthorised absence.


