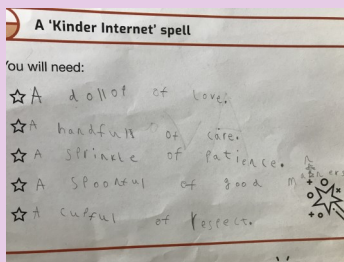
INTERNET/ONLINE SAFETY SECTION

Safer Internet Day

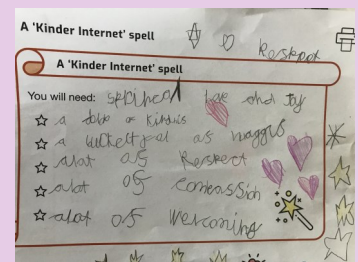
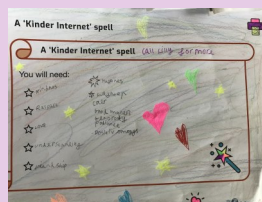
This week we have had Safer Internet Day. Each class has been learning about how to keep themselves and their friends safe online.



In school we use Childnet's **SMART** to teach our online safety rules. The adventures of Kara, Winston and the SMART crew are illustrate in 5 online safety **SMART** rules and include a real life SMART Crew of young people, who guide the cartoon characters in their quest, and help them make safe online decisions.
