INTERNET SAFETY SECTION

Be Share Aware - Talk to your child about being share aware and why they shouldn't give out any personal information. It's also important to talk to them about not sharing videos that they can be identified by - such as them wearing school uniforms or by road names for example. Remind them that anything they do on video chats can be recorded. They shouldn't fell pressured into doing anything that they feel uncomfortable about.

Coronavirus

We would like to give parents and carers some general advise from Public Health in regards to the Coronavirus. You should not be unduly worried about the possibility of your children catching the virus and there is no need for your child not to continue to attend school as normal. However, with the half term break, the government recommend you should avoid all but essential travel to China. If you are travelling to China, Thailand, Japan, Republic of Korea, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Singapore, Malaysia and Macau and also displaying symptoms of the virus then you should stay indoors, avoid contact with other people and telephone NHS 111 for further advice. Please contact NHS 111 if you have travelled to the Wuhan or Hubei Province of China in the last 14 days and avoid contact with other people.

As with normal recommendations, particularly at this time of the year with coughs, colds and sickness bugs, we would like to promote and remind children of basic hygiene practises, such as regularly washing hands thoroughly and always sneezing in to a tissue.
