School Uniform

Please can we remind parent and carers that children must come to school dressed in school uniform. Uniform does not need to have the school logo but must be grey or black trousers, skirts, shorts or blue pinafore dress in the summer, pale blue polo shirt or a shirt, navy blue jumper/cardigan or school fleece. **Hoodies must not be worn** unless your child has forest school. PE Kit is a white t-shirt with blue or black jogging bottoms, leggings or shorts. Please can children keep their PE Kit in school during the week in case they have a change or addition to a PE lessons - these can then be taken home for washing at the weekends. We also have a supply of second hand uniform costing 50p per item and is available by contacting Mrs Inglis, FLO or the school office.
