School Attendance

As promised in our School News last term we will be letting you know the school attendance figures at the end of each term. For Term 4 the **school attendance figure was 95%**, slightly down on this time last year. This attendance figure does not include approved Covid absence as schools had special arrangements for recording this. However, as from the beginning of Term 5, absence for Covid reasons will now be recorded the same as other illnesses.

This term we will also be focusing on punctuality. When children arrive later to school this can have a detrimental affect on their learning by them missing instructions from their teachers at the start of the lesson, feeling awkward walking in to the class whilst lessons have started and by not having time to settle in to the school day with their friends. We understand that sometimes this is unavoidable but we hope by encouraging good attendance this will help every child settle well in to school each morning.
