SMART WATCHES

This week we are focusing on Smart Watches. Smart Watches are becoming ever more popular and you may be considering one of these for your child as they move on to secondary school. Please do check as many schools, like Eastry, do not allow children to wear these to school.

There are also parent features available such as restricting time spent on the device, disabling smart features during school hours and preventing making or receiving calls from anyone not on the Smart Watch contact list.
