Absent from School

Please can we remind parents of the importance of letting us know if your child will not be in school. Please telephone the school office on 01304 611360 **before 9.00am** to let us know if they will not be in school and the reason for this so that any appropriate action can be taken if necessary.

If your child or any member of your household presents one of the following symptoms:

- High temperature
- A new continuous cough
- A loss or change to their sense of smell or taste.

You must stay at home, arrange a test and self-isolate for 7 days from when their symptoms started or until you receive a negative test result. Anyone in your house who does not have symptoms must self-isolate for 14 days from when the first person in your home started having symptoms.

Your child and you must also stay at home if:

you're waiting for a coronavirus test result

you've tested positive for coronavirus - this means you have coronavirus

you live with someone who has symptoms, is waiting for a test result or has tested positive

You must also follow any guidelines given by the NHS test and trace.

Please inform the school of the result of any test once known so that we can respond accordingly.
