Most children have the nasal spray vaccine which is the preferred vaccine. A vaccine injection is also available which does not contain gelatine from pigs (porcine gelatine).

Are you entitled to free schools meals, free holiday activity club and supermarket vouchers during school holidays and not receiving them?

All children from Fledglings to Year 6 may be entitled to receive these regardless of whether they are in reception, Year 1 & Year 2 and currently receiving the universal free school meals. In addition to continuing to receive a free school meal after Year 2, you will also receive holiday supermarket vouchers and holiday activity vouchers as soon as you have been accepted. Please can we remind you that we are a nut free school and have children who have nut allergies.


