Event planning

If you would like to be involved with planning the event, please come along to one of our planning meetings. The next meeting will take place on **Friday 16**th **September** at 7.45pm at The Five Bells. This meeting will last no more than one hour, and you can enjoy a drink with new friends (we are very friendly!)

There is also a meeting planned for **6th October** – more information to follow.

Help to set up on the day

We need help to erect gazebos and to set up lighting etc, on the morning of 4th November, from 9am. Help is also needed to set up stalls from 3.30pm.

Run a stall

We need people to run our games and refreshment stalls from 5-7.30pm (during the event). You will get to enjoy the fireworks with your family – stalls close during the display.

Marshals

We need marshals to support the event. This largely entails wearing a high-vis jacket, alerting first aiders and event organisers, if their help is needed (walkie talkies are provided) and being aware of and supporting evacuation, in event of an emergency. You will get to enjoy the fireworks with your family.

Help to tidy up on the day

After the event, help is needed to take down gazebos and lighting and to tidy away the stalls. This usually only takes about an hour after the event.

Firework sponsorship

The cost of fireworks has increased significantly, and we are looking for local businesses to kindly sponsor the event. Please let us know if you know of a company who may be willing to help, even in a small way – every little helps.

Entertainment
