## **INTERNET SAFETY SECTION**

#### **Protecting Android Devices**

You can set up restricted users on Android tablets through a Google account. Open settings menu (look for a cog icon) and select the 'Users' option. Here you can add new restricted user. After setting up a password and username, select which application you want to restrict access to. On an Android smartphone it's similar, but first select 'Parental Controls' in the playstore.

For Apple devices you can simply visit the preference/settings menu and within 'General' there is an option for 'Restrictions'. Here you can turn off any application or features on your child's device that you do not want them to have access to.
