We would like to inform you that the **school's attendance** figure at the end of Term 4 **is 96.3%**. The Government's guideline is 100% attendance however, realistically we understand that genuine illness can sometimes prevent school attendance. Please refer to our leaflet 'Illness, Attendance and Absence from School - A Guide for Parents and Carers' sent home in September and March which provides parents with lots of useful information about when your child should and should not attend school and general information about more common illnesses.
