Tuesday, 16th, Wednesday, 17th and Friday, 19th June - Father's Day Gift Shop

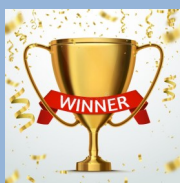

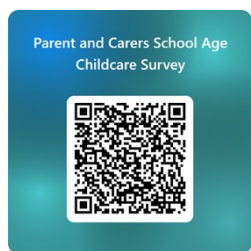
Uniform Orders through Brigade
