Use Wellbeing Settings and Apps

There are sites and apps which are specifically designed to help children with their online wellbeing.

- <u>BBC Own It</u> which gives advice as they chat to their friends online
- <u>Headspace for Kids</u> is an app to teach children the basics of mindfulness in a fun way. It's aimed at 3-12 year olds, with different content for different age groups. Free for headspace subscribers, limited access for non-subscribers.
- <u>JoyPoP</u> is an app designed to help users find their inner resilience to deal with the highs and lows in their daily lives. By rating mood for the day, users are directed to complete different activities to help switch to positive emotions. App costs £6.99.

You can also find out what apps your child uses the most and have a look to see if there are wellbeing guides which explain their settings to help support children's wellbeing.
