Harvest is a time in the calendar where we celebrate and give thanks for all the good things we have and to help celebrate harvest time this year, our school is taking part in Heroes Against Homelessness to raise funds for Porchlight, Kent's local homelessness charity. Further information about this charity was sent home with children last week. We will be holding a cake sale after school on Friday 27th September on the school playground (or in the school hall if the weather is wet). For a small donation we invite the staff and children to come to school dressed as heroes. The money raised will help rough sleepers and vulnerable people across Kent. So rather than providing a harvest food box this year please donate cakes or biscuits for our sale. Donations should be taken to your child's classroom today at the end of the school day, or tomorrow morning.

Whole School Meals are having a fun change of menu on this day which will be Burgers in a Bun or Vegetarian Sausages. Thank you for your continued support.

If you are not already in receipt of free school meals and feel that you may qualify for these, (even if your child is in Fledglings, Year 1 or 2 and receives the Universal Free School Meal), we would encourage you to apply for them. As well as your child receiving a nutritional meal the school also receives additional funding. This funding is used for extra staff and resources to support and enhance learning. It would make a drastic difference to our budget if this extra funding went unclaimed. Further information and application forms are available from the school office.
