
OPEN EVENING AND VIRTUAL TOURS

Flu Immunisation Programme

It is more important than ever this year that, were possible, we protect our children, their families and the more vulnerable in our community by supporting the school-age flu immunisation programme. For Eastry School this is due to take place in school on **Wednesday**, **25 November for all year groups**. A letter from Kent Community Health was emailed to all parents last week and a paper copy of this letter, together with a leaflet from Public Health England 'Protecting your child against flu', was also send home with the children. This leaflet should help to answer any questions that you may have around the vaccine which is a simple and painless nasal spray rather than in injection. You will see, from the letter, that parents are requested to complete the online form to consent or decline to the immunisation. We hope that as many parents as possible will sign up for the vaccine for their child/children.
