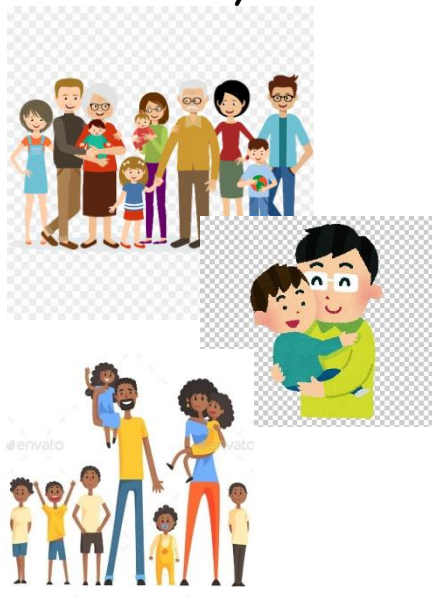


In Term 1 our topic is... **Who am I? Who is in my family?**
