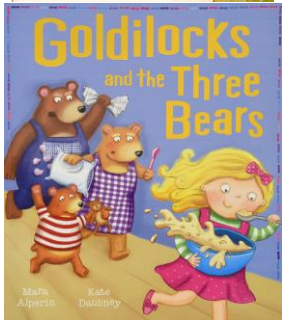
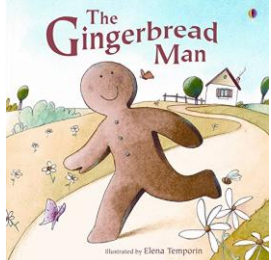
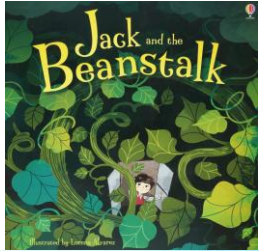


In Term 3 our topic is... **Traditional Tales!**
