| <b>IT HELPS IF I ALREADY KNOW</b> | <p>I know the words for family members in French and, with support, tell you what relation they are to me, how old they are and what they are called.</p> <p>I know numbers 1-100, count and use them in sequence.</p>  |

I can remember and follow most classroom commands in French.

I know how to write whether I live in a house or an apartment.

I know how to say and write where my house or apartment is after I have heard the options available to me.
