

Dear Parents & Carers,

**Year 3 visit to Kent Life, Maidstone for Stone Age Theme Day – Thursday, 30<sup>th</sup> April 2026**

On Thursday, 30<sup>th</sup> April I have arranged a visit for the children to attend the Stone Age theme day at Kent Life in Maidstone. We have attended this theme day in previous years which has always been greatly enjoyed by the children and they have gained a lot from the interactive nature of the day in supporting their learning about the Stone Age. The cost of this visit, which includes entrance to Kent Life, the Stone Age Workshop Day and coach travel their and back, will cost £29.00 per child.

We would encourage children to dress up in costume of the era or as an archaeologist but please ensure the costume is warm enough with suitable footwear. Please apply sun cream to your child before arriving to school if there weather will be sunny. Children should also bring a packed lunch, snack and water bottle (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks). If your child is entitled to a free school meal a pack lunch can be provided for them. Please indicate on the slip attached that this is required, if not ticked we will assume that you are providing them with your own packed lunch.

The day starts at 10.00am and I want to make sure we are there in time for a comfort break before the day starts. We have arranged a coach leaving at 8.30am and we will return leaving Kent Life at 2.45pm. **WE ARE THEREFORE ASKING THAT ALL CHILDREN ARRIVE TO SCHOOL AT 8.20AM ON THURSDAY, 30<sup>th</sup> April.** We expect the children to arrive back to school at approximately 4.00pm depending on traffic.

In line with legislation and the school governor's policy statement on the subject, we would like to remind you that no pupil will be prevented from going on an educational visit during school hours through inability to pay the voluntary payment request. (*If you are not able to pay please let the School Office know immediately*). **However, please note that it may be necessary to cancel the visit if sufficient voluntary contributions are not forthcoming.**
