END POINTS KNOWLEDGE	<p>PEOPLE OF GOD What is it like to follow God? I know that The Old Testament tells the story of a particular group of people, the children of Israel known as the People of God — and their relationship with God. I know that The People of God try to live in the way God wants, following his commands and worshipping him. I know that they believe he promises to stay with them and Bible stories show how God keeps his promises.</p> <p>SIKHISM What is important for Sikh people? INCARNATION (2 LESSONS I know that Sikhs believe that there is only one God, who they have several names for. (Waheguru) I know that Sikhs try to put the teachings and examples of the 10 gurus into daily practice by living a good life, treating everyone equally and sharing all they have. I know that is important for Sikh's to belong to a community of believers called the Khalsa. I know that Khalsa Sikhs wear 5 articles of faith which reminds them of their faith and duty as a Sikh.</p> <p>INCARNATION What is the Trinity? CORE LEARNING I know that Christians believe God is Trinity: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.</p>

I know that Christians believe The Father creates; he sends the Son who saves his people; the Son sends the Holy Spirit to his followers.

I know that Christians find that understanding God is challenging; people spend their whole lives learning more and more about God.

I know that Christians really want to try to understand God better and so try to describe God using symbols, similes and metaphors, in song, story, poems and art.

I know that Christians worship God as Trinity. It is a huge idea to grasp and Christians have created art to help to express this belief.

I know that Christians believe the Holy Spirit is God's power at work in the world and in their lives today, enabling them to follow Jesus.

SALVATION

Why do Christians call the day Jesus died 'Good Friday'?

CORE LEARNING

I know that Christians see Holy Week as the culmination of Jesus' earthly life, leading to his death and resurrection.

I know that the various events of Holy Week, such as the Last Supper, were important in showing the disciples what Jesus came to earth to do.

I know that Christians today trust that Jesus really did rise from the dead, and so is still alive today.

I know that Christians remember and celebrate Jesus' last week, death and resurrection.

KINGDOM OF GOD

When Jesus left, what was the impact of Pentecost?

I know that Christians believe that Jesus inaugurated the 'Kingdom of God' — i.e. Jesus' whole life was a demonstration of his belief that God is King, not just in heaven but here and now ('Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven').

I know that Christians believe Jesus is still alive, and rules in their hearts and lives by the Holy Spirit, if they let him.

	<p>I know that Christians believe that after Jesus returned to be with God the Father, he sent the Holy Spirit at Pentecost to help the Church to make Jesus' invisible Kingdom visible by living lives that reflect the love of God.</p> <p>I know that Christians celebrate Pentecost as the beginning of the Church.</p> <p>SIKHISM How do Sikh people worship and celebrate?</p> <p>I know that Sikhs can worship at any time or day, at home or in the Gurdwara.</p> <p>I know that Sikhs are expected to pray three times a day and mediate and recite words from the holy scriptures</p> <p>I know that Sikh people respect and regard The Guru Granth Sahib as a living Guru.</p> <p>I know that The Gurdwara is place that is welcome and open to everyone and is known as the 'doorway to the house of God'</p> <p>I know that all Sikhs are encouraged by their Guru (Guru Granth Sahib) to perform Seva or Selfless Service.</p> <p>I know that the Vaisakhi is the biggest and most important Sikh festival, where they remember the founding of the Khalsa and the Sikh New Year.</p>
<p>IT HELPS IF I ALREADY KNOW</p>	<p>I know that God created the universe.</p> <p>I know the Earth and everything in it are important to God.</p> <p>I know God has a unique relationship with human beings as their Creator and Sustainer.</p> <p>I know humans should care for the world because it belongs to God.</p> <p>I know Christians believe that Jesus is God and that he was born as a baby in Bethlehem.</p> <p>I know the Bible points out that his birth showed he was extraordinary (he is worshipped as a king, in Matthew) and that he came to bring good news (for example, to the poor, in Luke).</p> <p>I know Christians celebrate Jesus' birth; Advent for Christians is a time of getting ready for Jesus' coming.</p> <p>I know Christians believe Jesus brings good news for all people.</p> <p>I know for Christians, this good news includes being loved by God, and being forgiven for bad things.</p> <p>I know Christians believe Jesus is a friend to the poor and friendless.</p> <p>I know Christians believe Jesus' teachings make people think hard about how to live and show them the right way.</p> <p>I know Easter is very important in the 'big story' of the Bible. Jesus showed that he was willing to forgive all people, even for putting him on the cross.</p> <p>I know Christians believe Jesus builds a bridge between God and humans.</p> <p>I know Christians believe Jesus rose again, giving people hope of a new life.</p> <p>I know Sikh people learn about God wants them to behave through the example of Guru Nanak. (Guru means teacher)</p>
