END POINTS KNOWLEDGE

Creation

I know God the Creator cares for the creation, including human beings.
I know that human beings are part of God's good creation.
I understand that the Bible shows God wants to help people to be close to him — and gives guidelines on good ways to live (such as the Ten Commandments).

Incarnation

I understand that Christians believe God is Trinity: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
I know Christians understand the roles of the Father, the Son and the Holy-Spirit.
I know Christians see Jesus as what God the Father is like.
I know that understanding God is challenging to people.
I understand that Christians believe the Holy Spirit is God's power at work in the world.

Gospel

I know Christians believe Jesus challenges everyone about how to live.
I know Jesus shows love and forgiveness.
I know Christians try to be like Jesus
I know Christians try to put his teaching and example in a variety of ways.

Salvation

I know Christians see Holy Week as the culmination of Jesus' earthly life, leading to his death and resurrection.
I can explain events in Holy Week, such as the Last Supper.
