Maths

During term 1, we will be working on place value; addition and subtraction. The initial focus will be on numbers to 10,000. When the children are confident, they will then work with numbers to 1 million. Some of the skills taught will include rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000, counting in 10's 100's 1000's, 10,000 and 100,000.

<u>Times Tables:</u> Every day, the children will have the opportunity to practise their times tables in school through songs and games.

Homework for maths will be to practise your times tables for 15-20 minutes each day on Times Table Rock Stars (TTRS) or practise your quick recall of maths skills using Arithmagicians.

PE

PE will be outdoors on a **Monday afternoon**. The children will be participating and learning new skills in football.

During our first term in year 5 we will be engaging in the exciting topics of 'The Vikings' linked to History, and 'Space' linked with Science and English.

Science

This terms science topic is **Space** and our big question is; 'What makes up our solar system?
