

Dear Parents/Carers

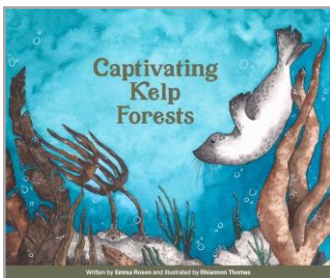

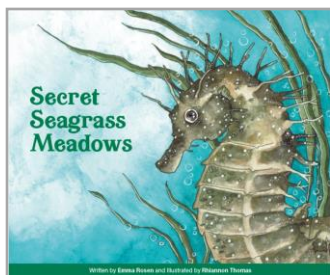
Sponsored by Natural England, the 'Discovering Marine and Coastal Habitats' series for kids (paperback £7.99):

Author Emma Rosen and artist Rhiannon Thomas team up for another beautiful rhyming story that children will want to read again and again.

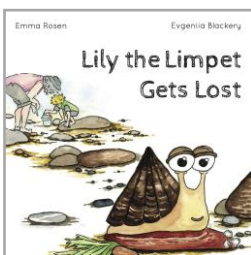


Discover the Secret Seagrass Meadows.

With Emma Rosen's gentle rhymes and Rhiannon Thomas's coastal watercolours, children will love this beautiful story.

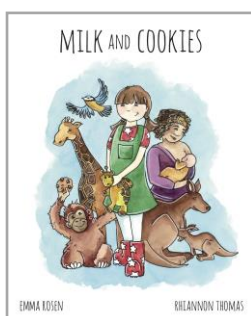
Other books:
