Welcome to Year 3- Tiger class

Topic: Our topic this term is **MIGHTY METALS**.

We will be covering some of the curriculum through this topic.

In **English**, we will be exploring a range of genres including instructional writing, descriptive writing, narrative writing and poetry.

Alongside this we will be building on the children's knowledge of GPS (grammar, punctuation and spelling). They will be looking at how to write in paragraphs, more on homophones and spelling using some suffix and prefix.

Maths will continue with addition and subtraction and then move on to counting in different multiples.

We will also continue with Maths 'fluency' building the children confidence in their times tables.

On **Wednesdays**, the children will continue to be taught by Mrs Prestleton.

This term, we are lucky enough to have PE twice a week. Children should remember to come to school in their **sports kit every Wednesday and Friday.** The focus in sport will be Badminton on Wednesdays and Netball (Ball skills) on Fridays.

Computing will consist of spreadsheets alongside the continuation of online safety and, in **PSHE** we will be celebrating differences

Forest School will take place on Friday afternoons. As always, please make sure you child has wellies and waterproofs in school every Friday. They can leave them on their peg from week to week in a NAMED bag.

*I am aware that this is the same day as we will have PE. I hope we can do PE first in the afternoon and then add layers for Forest school.

Foundation subjects:

In **DT** this term, we will be exploring pneumatics and levers and joints. Watch out for dojo messages for a few recyclable resources!

In **Art**, we will explore the use of different materials as well as learning a few drawing techniques using pastels and pencils.

French will look at the traditional tale of Little Red Riding Hood and we will learn the names of a few parts of the body.

In **Music** we will be looking at how Music can be written down.

The question that we will be exploring in **RE** this term is, 'What is the Trinity?'
