



Welcome to Term 6 Tiger Class



<p>This term our topic is based on the historic periods of:</p> <p><i>The Iron Age and the Roman Invasion of Britain</i></p>	<p>Reading: We will be reading a range of both non-fiction and fiction texts to support our learning and a particular focus will be continuing the book, 'Stig of the dump.'</p>
<p>English will linked to our topic and we will be exploring narrative (story writing), persuasive adverts, playscripts and diary entries. Alongside this, children will be taught <i>GPS</i> (grammar, punctuation and spelling) and we will be learning how to write direct speech accurately, spell homophones, use apostrophes and use the perfect tense in the correct context. Children will also have the opportunity to continue to write complex sentences using subordinate and main clauses.</p>	<p>In Maths, we will be focusing on shape and statistics along with continuing to practise telling the time and looking at money.</p>
	<p>Our RE learning this term will be an introduction to 'What is Humanism?'</p>
<p>Forest school: This will continue on Monday's. Please ensure your child has access to putting on long sleeves/trousers and wellies whatever the weather. If it is particularly warm, they can bring these long layers in a bag to change in to before we head out.</p>	<p>Swimming: In Term 6 we have swimming. This will be for the first 6 Thursdays. Please remember to bring swimming things, (goggles/hats- if you prefer) and a towel in a suitable bag. The lessons will take place in the mornings and we will return to school afterwards in time for lunch.</p>
<p>PE and Sport's Day: For the first 3 weeks of the term, please can the children arrive at school on Wednesdays in their PE kit. This will enable them to practise for sport's day. Sport's Day is on Friday 21st June. After Sport's day, they will be able to come to school in their normal uniform, each Wednesday.</p>	<p>Water bottles: As the weather warms up, please can children have a full water bottle in school to drink throughout the day. This must be water only and children may wish to have an additional juice drink with their lunch.</p> <p>Hats and Sun cream too please!</p>
<p>Home learning: As part of home learning, children are expected to read for at least 15 mins, 5 x per week. This should be recorded in their yellow reading record, which should be brought to school with their reading book each day. Many thanks for the many who are supporting in this way already!</p>	<p>Times table Rockstar: A reminder that children should regularly be accessing Times Table Rockstars. This is a valuable resource to support children to learn and recall their times tables.</p>
