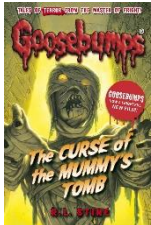


Year 4 Class Information Term 1:

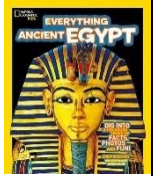
Can we walk, talk and live like Egyptians??

Please find some useful information about our routines and our curriculum this term, to help you help the children make the most of their learning.

We are really looking forward to inviting the children into Year 4 this year for an exciting year and helping the children to complete and enjoy their learning. Teaching the class will be Mrs Gleave supported by Mrs Kemp. The class will also be taught by Mrs Prestleton on a Thursday morning.



English: During term 1, we will focus on two texts – Goosebumps ‘The Curse of the Mummy’ RL Stine We will be using the themes in the next to help us write a new chapter for the book. ‘Everything Ancient Egypt’ will give us ideas for writing non-chronological reports and we will also be creating a persuasive advert to visit Ancient Egypt!

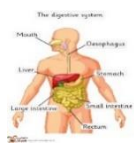


During our VIPERS reading sessions, we will be looking at making predictions based on the information we have been given and using texts to improve our vocabulary which will help with our writing.

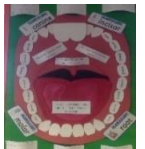
Mathematics: Following White Rose Maths, we will start the year by looking at place value. Children will look at numbers up to 10,000 in different representations such as partitioning and on a number line. Following this, we will complete work on addition and subtraction of up to 4-digits.



Alongside this, we will be focussing on times tables ahead of government assessments.



Science: Animals including humans –What are the processes involved when animals digest food.



Computing: Our safety focus this term will be on privacy and security - helping us keep our identities safe online and who to contact if we have an issue. We will then be putting this into practise by using search engines safely and efficiently.

RE: Christianity – What do Christians learn from the creation story?

Thinking about the wonders in our world and what we can learn from the story of Adam and Eve.



History: Comparing ancient and modern Egypt. In addition to this, how pyramids were made and what Egyptians traded.



Geography: Focus on the location of Egypt before looking at features of river systems, the stages of a river, and finally the water cycle process.

Spellings and vocabulary

These are the spellings and vocabulary we are focusing on this term. Children should complete these at home at least 5 times a week using Spelling Bee. Log ins are in their reading records. This is accessible on pc/laptops or by downloading the app on mobile phones.
