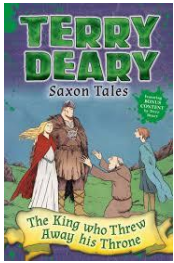


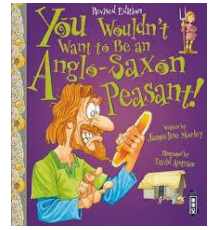
Year 4 class information for Term 6:

Why did the Anglo-Saxons choose Britain?

Welcome to Term 6. Children will have P.E and Forest School on Wednesdays with Mrs Prestleton.

English: We will be linking our History learning about Anglo-Saxons to our writing by writing a newspaper article about the arrival of the travellers to Britain. We will also write a playscript based on one of the historical events we learn about.



During our VIPERS reading sessions, we will be using *Saxon Tales* by Terry Deary as well as several non-fiction texts to practise retrieval, summarising and inference based on the information we have been given in the text.

Mathematics: Following White Rose Maths, we will be completing our Year 4 curriculum with Shape, Statistics and Position and Direction. Children will continue to practise their times tables.



Science: Making connections – How does the flow of liquid compare?

This topic revises all of the topics we have covered in Year 4. Children will be able to check their understanding and knowledge and consolidate their learning.
