Dear Year 5 Parents,

**Kent Test**

Kent Grammar School test is due to take place on Thursday, 8th September, 2022. Should you wish your child to sit the Kent Test you will need to register between 1 June and 1 July, 2022 as late applications cannot be accepted. If you register online and provide an email address, then you will receive your child's assessment decision via email. The date for this hasn't been confirmed but is usually mid-October.

Parents are encouraged to register online, as this will allow Kent to process your details more quickly. Also, once you have your child's results, parents who registered online will be able to apply online for a school place simply by logging on and adding your preferences to the information you have already given them about your child and your address. Parents who wish to also register for the entrance tests for Dover Girls Grammar School or Dover Grammar School for Boys need to register with the school. Further details regarding this were sent to Year 5 parents recently.
