Dear Parents,

This term the children will be busy revising for their KS2 SATs which will take place in week 4.

Please see the timetable below:

Monday 11 May 2026	English grammar, punctuation and spelling Papers 1 and 2
Tuesday 12 May 2026	English reading
Wednesday 13 May 2026	Mathematics Papers 1 and 2
Thursday 14 May 2026	Mathematics Paper 3

Each day, the tests will begin at 9am and children are invited into school early for a Y6 breakfast. There will be no tests in the afternoons and no tests on Friday (this will be a fun day!).

It is essential that children continue to complete their daily home learning practise of EdShed and Maths.co.uk, as well as their weekly written home learning in order to be prepared for the tests.
