### Dropping and Collecting from School

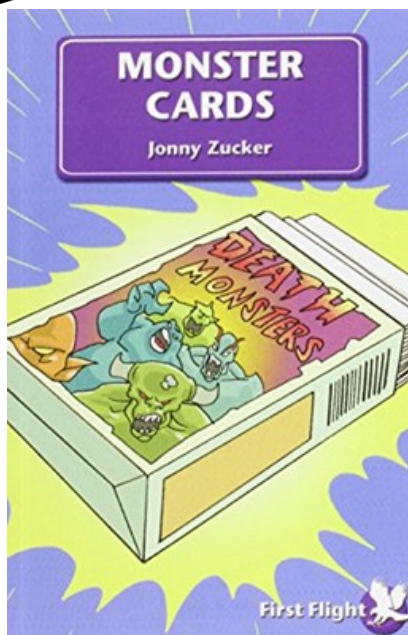
