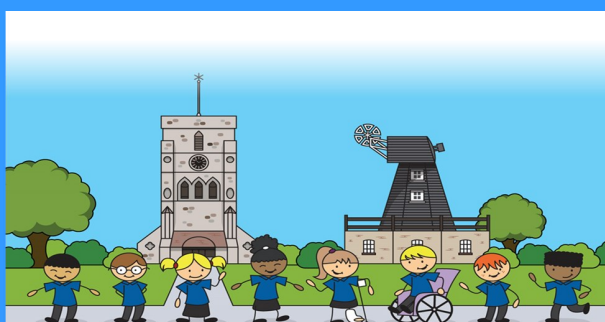
OPEN DAY
